

Tennessee Star of Tomorrow Scholarship

The Tennessee Star of Tomorrow award annually recognizes star qualities in a male and female Tennessee USBC Youth member who competes in the sport of bowling. Star qualities include distinguished *certified* bowling performances on the local, state and national level, academic achievement and extra-curricular activities. The winners will each receive a \$500 scholarship which will be formally presented by the Tennessee State USBC Bowling Association at the annual awards banquet.

Eligibility and Requirements

Applicant must:

1. Go to Tnbowling.com and fill in contact information, print and submit with all other paperwork
2. Be a current Tennessee State USBC Youth member, age 15 – 20 (age Aug 1, current year)
3. Be a USBC Youth member in good standing
4. Not have previously won the Tennessee Star of Tomorrow Scholarship
5. List current grade, high school, city, and expected graduation month and year
6. Submit current league average, number of games
7. Submit number of weeks bowled in your current league
8. List any scholarships you have received by name and amount
9. Return all completed documentation and application to the Tennessee State USBC Bowling Association SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE post-marked no later than June 15 of the current year.

1. Include at least two letters of reference (by a teacher, principal or employer, etc.)
2. Include an official or unofficial school transcript with current GPA and what scale it is based on

1. List any AP/Honors courses you have completed or are currently taking
2. List all scholastic honors or awards
3. List all extracurricular activities such as Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts or bowling offices held
4. List any high school sports played and number of years played

Please answer the following questions on a separate sheet of paper. Please include as much detail as possible.

1. Number of weeks prebowled or postbowled and why
2. Highest certified career league average
3. Highest top three game scores and dates bowled
4. Highest top three series scores and dates bowled
5. List your highest bowling performances in tournaments – dates, titles, scores and place finished
6. List other bowling involvements and honors -- years, organizations, activities, offices, special awards
7. List which tournament(s) (State - Pepsi - Top 5) you participated in last year and number of years prior?

SECTION D: COMMUNITY SERVICE

Please answer the following questions on a separate sheet of paper. Please include as much detail as possible.

1. List community volunteer activities and years involved

SECTION E: ESSAY

Please submit an essay of 100 words or less on how the lessons you have learned through academics, community involvement and bowling have influenced your life, your goals for the future and reasons for applying for this scholarship.
