The Tennessee Star of Tomorrow award annually recognizes star qualities in a male and female Tennessee USBC Youth member who competes in the sport of bowling. Star qualities include distinguished *certified* bowling performances on the local, state and national level, academic achievement and extra-curricular activities. The award winners will each receive a \$500 scholarship. This scholarship will be formally presented by the Tennessee State USBC Bowling Association.

## ELIGIBILITY AND REQUIREMENTS

1. Be a current Tennessee State USBC Youth member in the 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup> or 12<sup>th</sup> grade of high school.
2. Be a USBC Youth member in good standing.
3. Have a current GPA of 3.0 or better, based on a 4.0 scale
4. A completed application
5. Include at least two letters of reference (by a teacher, principal, employer, etc.)
6. Include an official or unofficial school transcript
7. Return all completed documentation and application to the Tennessee State USBC Bowling Association post- marked no later than **FEBRUARY 1, 2018.**
